EXAMPLES OF EXPERIENCE

- + Birchington southern extension: Support in promotion of Site through local plan process (+1,600 homes, school and country park), landscape appraisals and evolving the masterplan with a wide project team, presentations at community consultation and facilitating community workshops. Submission has included LVIA, landscape design, landscape masterplanning, currently in its determination stage.
- + Newtown Works, mixed use £240m redevelopment including film studios. Design and planning stages of an extensive public realm, also landscape design considerations for hotel, film studios, commercial and residential reuse of historic and Listed locomotive sheds. The project included a Townscape and Visual Impact Assessment.
